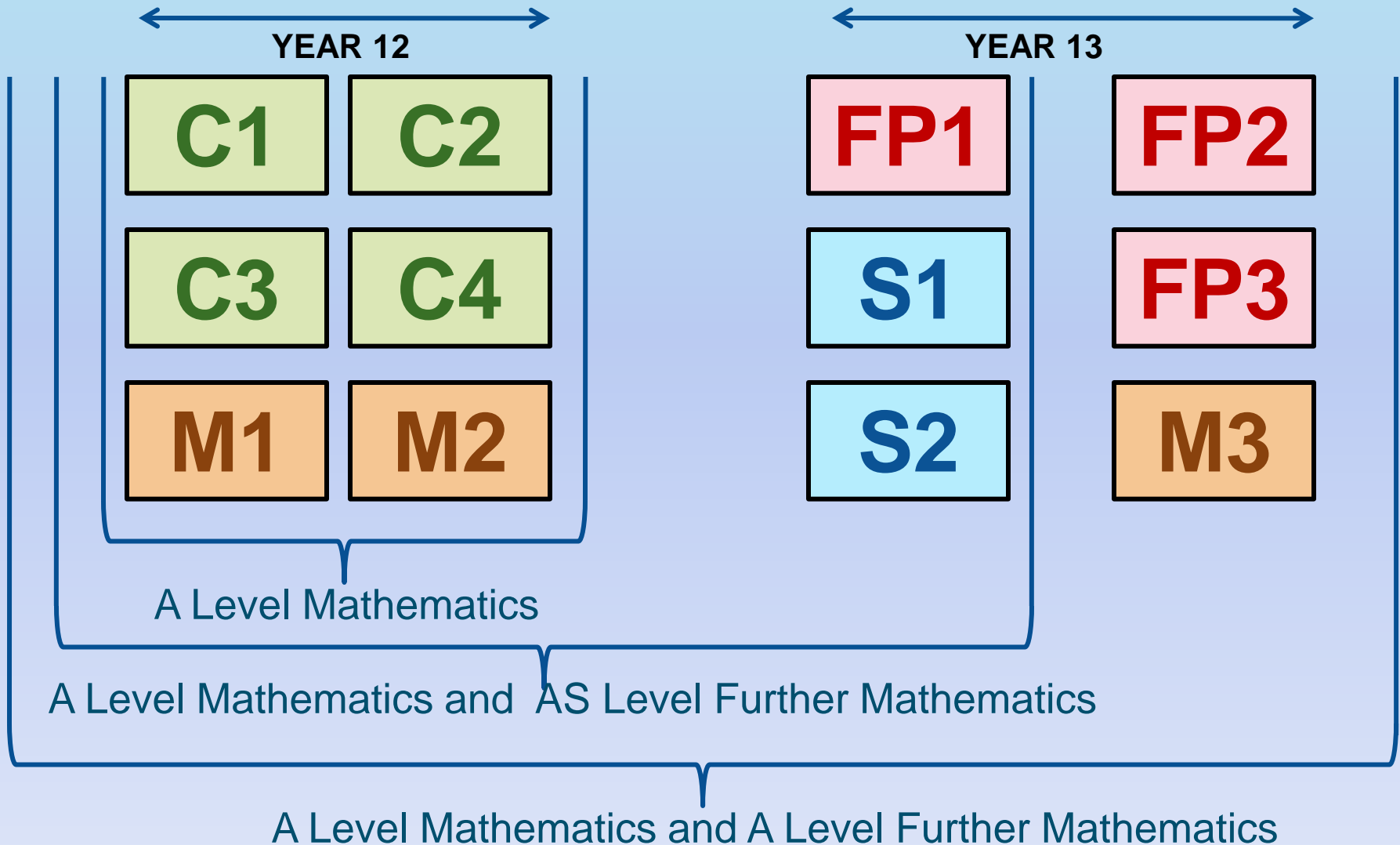

Mathematics Higher Level
