- * Blouse - regulation long sleeved
- * Trousers - regulation black "bootleg" style
- * Fleece scarf - regulation green

PERSONAL APPEARANCE

ALL girls should dress appropriately for school and therefore hem lengths on regulation dresses and tunics should be no more than 10cm above the knee.

Hair should be tied back. Hair fastenings may be dark green, brown or black, or white in Summer.

JEWELLERY

Watches only may be worn with school uniform and these must be clearly named via engraving. If earrings have to be worn because of pierced ears, small stud earrings in either gold or silver only are allowed, one in the lobe of each ear. Any other jewellery will be confiscated.

It is essential for Health & Safety reasons that all watches, earrings and religious symbols are removed for PE lessons. Your daughter should have a suitable container in which to place such items, which she should give to the member of the PE staff teaching her at the time before the lesson begins.

Girls are **NOT** allowed to wear make-up to school.
