Please note carefully the items on this list as we feel it is important parents do not waste money purchasing clothing which is not required.

ALL TERMS

- * Coat - black "3 in 1" recommended
- * Regulation green v-neck jumper
- * Regulation green blazer recommended
- * Pleated skirt - regulation green 20" length (available from Pullens only)
- * Trousers - regulation black "bootleg" style
- White laboratory coat (for Art and Science)
- * Blouse - regulation - long-sleeved in Autumn and Spring Terms, short-sleeved in Summer
- * Fleece scarf - regulation green or plain black scarf
- * Tights - black, opaque for Years 7, 8 and 9; black for Years 10 and 11
- * Ankle socks for Summer Term - green or plain white
- Shoes - sensible black (**not suede, not boots and not flat black ballet pumps**)
No heels to be more than 5 cm high
- * Shoe bags - 2 are required
- "Active Backcare" black school bag recommended
- House Polo Shirt - these can be ordered via the School and will be charged to the School bill

GAMES EQUIPMENT

- * Regulation white "polo" shirt with green collar and cuffs
- * Regulation white games sweatshirt with logo
- * Regulation green tracksuit - "splash top" and trousers for Years 9-11
- * Regulation black, green and white tracksuit (ordered from SILVERFX) for Years 7 and 8
- * Regulation green games skirt
- * Green knickers to be worn under green games skirt
- * Black leotard for Gym and Dance (Years 7-9)
- * Regulation black athletics shorts
- * Regulation green and white lacrosse socks
- Football boots for Lacrosse - moulded studs
- White trainers for outdoor use
- White trainers for indoor use (these must have black laces and must **not** be black soled)

PERSONAL APPEARANCE

ALL girls should dress appropriately for school. Hair should be tied back. Hair fastenings may be dark green, brown or black.

JEWELLERY

Watches only may be worn with school uniform and these must be clearly named via engraving. If earrings have to be worn because of pierced ears, small stud earrings in either gold or silver only are allowed, one in the lobe of each ear. Any other jewellery will be confiscated.
